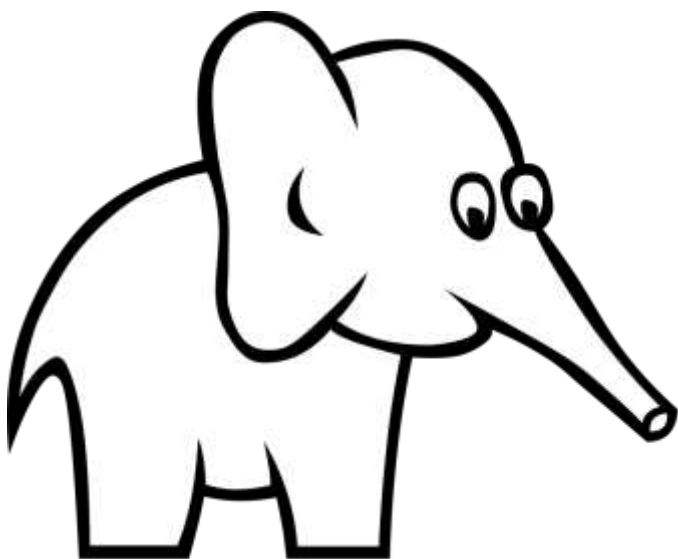




The Short Circuit
