**Program:** Tall Ship Adventures!: Nancy H. Richardson

Having sailed 103 tall ships on all seven seas, Nancy says "we can count ships but it's shipmates that count." She is known for connecting youth, tall ships, sail training, and marine education worldwide. Highlights include friends from sailing *Europa* in Antarctica; *USCG Eagle* to Panama; *Sea Cloud* transAtlantic; and brigantines *Irving Johnson* and *Exy Johnson* out of LA.



Capt. Irving Johnson and his wife, Exy inspired Nancy when she was a Girl Scout Mariner in high school in NJ. Nancy is still sailing tall ships with youth-of-all-ages. Her current adventure is organizing an 'Educators Summit on Ocean Literacy' as part of Tall Ships America's 46<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference in San Pedro, February 23-27, 2019.

Nancy has been an art teacher, department chair, and dean of students in public and private high schools. 'Retired' after many years on the national staff of Girl Scouts of the USA, she continues as a lead volunteer with Tall Ships America (ASTA); Sail Training International, U.S. Sailing Association; National Maritime Historical Society and LA Maritime Institute TopSail Youth Program.

Everyone who obtains their first ham radio license through a PVARC VE test session, regardless of age, will receive a free membership in the Palos Verdes Amateur Radio Club for the remainder of the current calendar year.




