SS Cape May (AKR-5063) Length 876', Draft 40'

Earthquake was 10 KM West of Capital of Port-au-Prince. 7.0 Magnitude, depth 13KM, and after-shocks of 5.9 and 5.5

300,000 people died, and hundreds of thousands of survivors were displaced.

Cellular phone service was down for 3 days. The SS Cape May was in service for 3 months and used 13 tons of water a day.
