



## **K6PV PVARC Repeater**

The K6PV repeater is a dual mode repeater operating from the top of the Palos Verdes Peninsula at 1240 feet above sea level. The repeater provides excellent coverage throughout the Los Angeles region.

Operating on a frequency of 447.120 MHz and a frequency split of -5.0 MHz, the repeater is configured to provide both analog FM and DMR.

K6PV is an open repeater available to all licensed amateurs to use and enjoy.

### **25 KHz FM**

**447.120 MHz, -5.0 MHz offset with a PL of 100 Hz**

The PVARC weekly analog net takes place at 1930 hours, Pacific Time, each Tuesday evening on FM. This net also operates a cross band link on 144.910 MHz with a PL of 156.7 Hz to allow coverage to the western part of the Palos Verdes Peninsula from Point Vicente north to Malaga Cove. Visitors are always welcome.

### **DMR**

**447.120 MHz, -5.0 MHz offset, color code 1**
