Check out <a href="https://illw.net">https://illw.net</a> for details. Here in CA this kicks off at 1700 on Friday, 8/20, and ends at 1700 on Sunday, 8/21. Bill usually pulls a Class C motorhome into the Point Fermin Lighthouse parking, rolls out a side room with a single 100 or 200-watt station and primarily feeds a home brewed hex beam that covers from 20 meters and up. Lower bands are possible but rarely productive. The hot paths are usually to VK and ZL lighthouses on Friday and Saturday night. Mornings have found LH's in EU and AF and afternoons usually pick up a few in SA and the Caribbean. Due to the LH ID exchange consider this a J3E and A1A activation and


