A Correction in the URAC historical record:

The following is excerpted from a letter to Stephen Stanbuk in September, 1992 from M.C. Zervantian, W6DIS:

A SHORT TIME BEFORE CHRISTMAS 1933 A FEW HAMS MET AT THE HOME OF RAY

TUTTLE, W6HBC, IN WIMINGTON. WE MADE PLANS TO FOR AN AMATEUR RADIO CLUB. IT BEING TOO NEAR CHRISTMAS TO DO VERY MUCH WE AGREED TO WAIT UNTIL THE FIRST OF THE NEXT YEAR, 1934

PRESENT AT THIS MEETIN WERE, RAY TUTTLE W6HBC

GENE TODD W6BBY

MC ZERVANTIAN W6DIS

THE ABOVE ARE THE ONLY NAMES I AM ABLE TO RECALL, I KNOW THERE WERE OTHERS THAT RAY HAD SPOKEN TO AND VERY LIKELY HAD MEETINGS THAT I WAS NOT IN ATENDANCE.

EARLY IN 1934 WE MET IN A SMALL HOUSE ON AMAPOLA ST IN TORRANCE. THIS

HOUSE WAS A SECOND HOUSE ON THE LOT IN BACK OF ALARGER HOUSE. I BELIEVE IT WAS OWNED BY A PERSON WHO ASPIRED TO BE A HAM.

JESS YOUNG W6HJO PRESIDENT

GE E TODD W6BBY VICE PRESIDENT

THE WOULD BE HAM ABOVE WAS SECRETARY-TREASURER

MC ZERVANTIAN W6DIS SOLD TICKETS FOR THE

DOOR PRIZE WE HAD A DISCUSSION ABOUT THE CLUBS NAME. SEVERAL NAMES WERE SUGGESTED.

I DO NOT REMEMBER HOW MANY MEETINGS WE HAD AT TORRANCE, THERE

THE SELECTED NAME, UNITED RADIO AMATEURS CLUB, THE SUGGESTION OF EMIL PONSO, W6'CMK, WAS SELECTED BY A VOTE.

WE DECIDED ON. HOLDING MEETINGS EVERY OTHER FRIDAY EVE.

NOT MANY. GENE, W6BBY SCOUTED ABOUT AND LOCATED THE BANNING HOME IN WILMINGTON AND ARRANGED FOR ITS USE. IT WAS A FINE PLACE, LARGE AND IT HAD A KITCHEN. WE HAD HOT CHOCOLATE AFTER THE MEETINGS. -WHOEVER WON THE DOOR PRIZE DID THE DISHES!

AFTER A SHORT TIME THE PRESIDENT, JESS YOUNG, W6HJO FOUND IT NECESSA Y TO MOVE FROM T.HE AREA AND GENE TODD., W6BBY BECAME PRESIDENT. M C-ZERVANTIAN, W6DIS WAS ELECTED VICE PRESIDENT.

WEHAD A GREAT GANG! WE ALL ENJOYED THE GET TOGETHERS!

RADIO SUPPLY IN LOS ANGELES DONATED ITEMS FOR OUR RAFFLE AND MANY CRO!CEITEM WERE OBTAINED IN THIS MANNER, THIS WAS EARLY 1934, THE TIMES: t E EEAN!

I HAVE MADE A LIST OF NAMES WITH CALLS OF THOSE I AM ABLE TO RECALL OF THIS PERIOD.

THE ARRL IN QST ANNOUNCED FIELD DAY. WE DECIDED TO PARTICIPATE!

I SUDDENLY FOUND THAT SINCE I WAS THE ONE WHO SOLD THE DOOR PRIZE TICKETS

AND THE RAFFLE TICKETS, I WAS THE "ACTIVITIES MANAGER!" IT WAS MY DUTY

TO PUT THE CLUB INTO THE FIELD DAY CONTEST! I WAS OF COURSE BACKED UP

BY A COMMITTEE! HARRY ADAMS, W6CSO PROMISED A RECEIVER, BILL BRADFORD, W6HCF HAD A WASHING MACHINE GASOLINE ENGINE THAT WAS EQUIPED WITH A FOOT PEDAL STARTER AND A GENERATOR DELIVERING I THINK IT WAS 500 VOLTS. BUT IT WAS FAR FROM PURE DC! JAMES HOMS4Y OF THE FCC SAID THAT SINCE WE WOULD BE ON THE PALOS VERDES HILL TOP AND THAT THE FCC MONITORING STATION WAS SO CLOSE ANY CW SIGNAL THAT WAS FROM SUCH A CLOSE SOURCE COULD SOUND
