Our main fundraiser will be to sell items donated to the club. We will do this at the TRW Swap Meet in the next couple of months, date to be determined. (Possibly March 30)


If you have extra ham-related items or electronic items, please donate them. Contact me or Bill Heather to arrange pickup. Please go through your shack or garage and find items to donate.
